The Pet Pantry was established by the Friends of Norfolk Animal Care Center as part of a surrender prevention program, and is totally run by volunteers.

Can I get food for my pets?

You may be eligible for free pet food and supplies if you meet the following criteria:

- you are facing financial hardship
- live in southside Hampton Roads
- are currently receiving government financial assistance, or
- have a combined household income of less than \$30,000
